Dear Mr. Franzese:

Please find enclosed the revised plan approval for the construction of a natural-gas-fired combined-cycle power plant consisting of two (2) identical 1 x 1 powerblocks each consisting of a combustion gas turbine and a steam turbine with duct burners and heat recovery steam generators at the proposed Renovo Energy Center located in the Borough of Renovo, Clinton County. A Department operating permit will subsequently be issued IF: (1) the special conditions incorporated within the plan approval have all been fulfilled, (2) it has been demonstrated to the Department's satisfaction that the project was carried out as proposed in the application and that the operation of the source(s) and any associated air pollution control equipment conforms with the operational information stated on the application, and (3) it has been demonstrated to the Department's satisfaction that the air contaminant emissions from the source(s) are in compliance with the requirements specified in, or established pursuant to, all applicable Department Rules and Regulations.

Plan Approval 18-00033B was originally issued on April 29, 2021. Pursuant to Section B, Condition #006(c) of the plan approval, this revised plan approval extends the expiration date to reflect the revised commencement of construction date as detailed by the company in your correspondences dated June 28, 2022, and July 19, 2022. The expiration date of the plan approval has been revised to April 27, 2024. Please include the following identification number with any correspondence to the Department concerning this Plan Approval: 18-00033B.

The Department advises Renovo Energy Center that the terms and conditions of Plan Approval 18-00033B will be revised at a later date in accordance with the adjudication and final rulings resulting from the appeal of the plan approval in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Environmental Hearing Board (EHB) Docket 2021-055-R. Any contractual, purchase or construction activities conducted shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the plan approval, the future revised plan approval and in accordance with the adjudication and final rulings resulting from the appeal of the plan approval in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Environmental Hearing Board. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the plan approval, including the revised plan approval resulting from the EHB rulings, may be considered a violation of Air Quality regulations.

This plan approval contains special conditions which must be fulfilled. Failure to do so constitutes a violation of Section 127.25 of the Department's Rules and Regulation, upon which legal action could be taken, and such failure is also grounds for denial of a regular operating permit.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board) pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. Appeals must be filed with the Board within 30 days of receipt of notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.
